- Ecumenical Worship at Athens Cemetery and Toledo Cross at 7AM
- Ecumenical Worship at Seeley's Bay Dock at 8AM
- Holy Eucharist at Lombardy and Newbliss at 9AM
- Holy Eucharist at Athens at 11AM
- Holy Eucharist at St. Luke's (at Olivet United Church) at 11:30AM

- We will have regional opportunities to gather for worship and fellowship in Holy Week: Maundy Thursday (Mar 28th) 6 PM at Holy Trinity Oak Leaf with potluck Agape meal and Eucharist; Great Vigil (Sat.
