So God made the space and separated the waters. Some water was above the space and some was below. God named the space "Sky."


And there was evening and there was morning, the second day.

But God saw that there was a good man named Noah. God told Noah to build an ark.





The dove came back with an olive branch showing that the flood was over.






God told Noah to leave the ark and to let the animals roam over the earth. Noah promised to always listen to God.
