

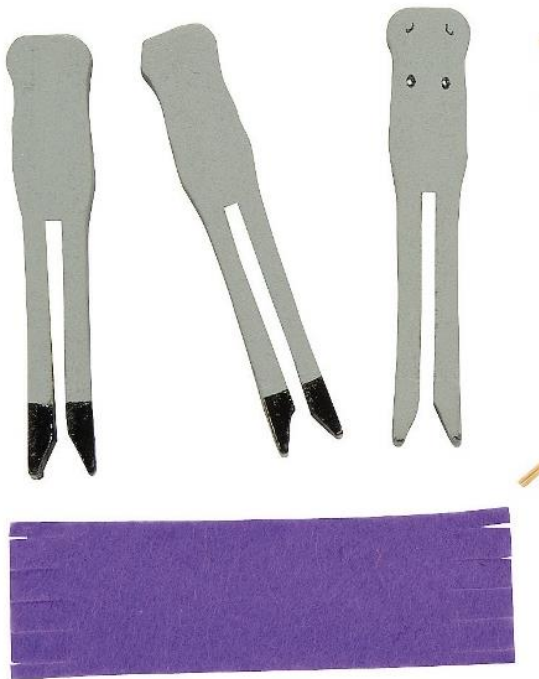

Day 4: Colt for a King

Craft, Activity, and Snack

Craft: Clothes Peg Colt

Glue three clothes pegs together to make the body and head of a donkey/colt. Glue googly eyes on the face and draw nostrils; colour in the hooves; cut a piece of felt for the cloak on the colt’s back.



Activity: Racing Colt

Colour and cut out the two pictures of Jesus riding the colt. Glue to paper plates. Poke a small hole in the centre of both plates and the bottom of a paper cup. Fix one end of elastic to a paper clip and thread other end through one of the plates and then through the bottom of the cup, pulling the elastic through until the paper clip is tight to the plate and the plate and bottom of the cup are together. Bend open the second paper clip so you can use it like a hook. Hook it into the open end of the elastic and thread the elastic through the second plate – you’ll have to stretch the elastic a bit. With the hook still pulling the elastic through the second plate, thread a bead onto the elastic, then place a skewer through the end of the elastic and remove the hook. The skewer should be off-centre and extend beyond the edge of the plate.



Wind up your toy by spinning the skewer around the plate and then put it on the floor and watch it go!
