

Ascension to Pentecost Story Cups Craft

Supplies

2 x Paper coffee cups

Tape and Glue stick

Wooden skewer

Cotton balls

Brad fastener

Jesus, Disciples, and
Flames Cut outs

Substitutions

you can even use recycled cups – just rinse and dry them first

long thin stick, or two popsicle sticks taped together

crumpled or rolled up paper

Bend a pin near the top (like a pin that holds a Remembrance Day Poppy) – just remember to tape the pointed end to the inside of the cup when you get to that step.

Don't worry if you don't have a printer – draw your own – just make sure they will fit on the side of your cup.

Print and cut out the figures of
Jesus, the Disciples, and the flames



Hold the oval cut out of Jesus to the side of one of the cups, and lightly mark the edges. Put the figure of Jesus aside and carefully cut out the oval you marked on the cup.



Tape the two cups together and poke a skewer through the centre of the bottom of the cups



Tape Jesus to the end of the skewer above the cut-out hole and tape the flames to the other end of the skewer.



Glue or tape cotton ball clouds above the cut hole.



Push a brad fastener through the centre of the picture of the disciples and through the bottom cup (the one without the hole). This way, you will be able to spin the disciples to watch Jesus disappear into the clouds or to watch as tongues of flame appear over their heads.



Now you can tell the story of Ascension and Pentecost!
